Place value - Recognising H, T and U within numbers to aid addition and subtraction. Recognising number patterns.

Recognise, find, name and write fractions - finding $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{5}$, $\frac{1}{6}$, $\frac{2}{3}$ of a number

4 written methods - using all four operations to solve worded problems.

Measurement - measuring length/width (m/cm) measuring weight (g/kg)

Literacy

Focus books: Laika by Owen Davey and The Man on the Moon by Simon Bartran
