

## Numeracy

**Four operations:** written and mental methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division

**Exploring Fractions:** unit and non-unit fractions, finding fractions of amounts, improper fractions and multiplying proper fractions.

**Shape:** recognising and drawing quadrilaterals as polygons and identifying their properties.

**Measure:** revising metric units of weight, capacity and length.



# Wylde Green Primary School Curriculum Overview

## Literacy

A series of creative writing lessons based around the novel Holes by the author Louis Sachar. Children will be getting into character to write letters and diaries from various characters point of view to retell events from the book. A focus on improving our openers, expanding our vocabulary banks and introducing punctuation such as brackets, dashes and commas.

## History/ Geography

**History:** Children to use a variety of sources to establish what life was like when Hadrian's Wall was built, investigate the rise of The Berlin Wall, demonstrate their knowledge of significant walls in history and to investigate the defense and attack features of different types of castles.

**Geography:** Compare and contrast the information that can be obtained through the use of an atlas or Google Earth when investigating The Great Wall of China.
